Prescott National Forest Rescinds Fire Restrictions On Saturday, August 19 at 6:00 A.M.

PRESCOTT, AZ – August 17, 2023 – The Prescott National Forest will lift all fire restriction on Saturday, August 19, 2023, at 6:00 a.m. Stage 1 restrictions have been in place across the forest since June 29. Fire managers continually evaluate conditions across the forest to help determine when to implement or rescind fire restrictions. Enough rain has fallen across the forest to increase fuel moisture levels and decrease fire danger.

The public should remain vigilant while visiting the forest, regardless of restriction levels. Leaving your campfire unattended is illegal all year round. Campfires must be dead out – cold to the touch – before you walk away. Fireworks are always prohibited on National Forest Land.
