On Tuesday November 4th from 5pm – 6pm, we will be hosting an Open House to officially welcome our new truck to Station 41 complete with a “Pushing in “ceremony where we ask community members to join our agency members in pushing in our new engine into the apparatus bay at Station 41.

Push-in ceremonies date back to the 17th century, when all fire fighting apparatus were pulled by horses and then had to be pushed back into the apparatus bay upon returning from calls for service.
